DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Percolate is a combination of surfactants designed to increase volumetric water content and improve water infiltration on golf course fairways, greens and tees as well as sports turf. Always mix and apply Percolate in accordance with label instructions.

Use Rates

Apply Percolate at the rate of 4 to 6 fl oz (148 mL) in a minimum of 1 gallon (3.79 L) of water per 1,000 sq ft (92.9 m²) of turfgrass.

Apply Percolate at the rate of 220 fl oz (6.51 L) in a minimum of 44 gallons (167 L) of water per acre (0.40 ha) of turfgrass.

Inject Percolate at a rate of 32 fl oz (0.95 L) every 7–10 days. Monitor and adjust rate until the desired level of performance is achieved.
