FOR SPILLS AND LEAKS**CONTAINMENT:**

Small spills: Sweep up carefully while avoiding the formation of a dust cloud. Place in an approved chemical waste container for disposal. Rinse spill area with a small amount of soapy water. Contain and absorb the rinsate with inert absorbents and place into the same disposal container. The area can be washed with water to remove the last trace residue. Do not allow spilled material to enter any body of water.

CLEANUP: Clean up spill immediately. Vacuum or sweep up material and place in a chemical waste container. Wash area with soap and water. Pick up wash liquid with additional absorbent and place in a chemical waste container.
