Use Contec DG[®] Dispersing Granule Technology 20-0-16 for fairways and other turf areas where a high nitrogen and potassium fertilization is desired.

Watering in this product will disperse each granule into thousands of particles. This will facilitate the movement of the nutrients into the soil. This particle dispersion will also greatly reduce ball, shoe and mower pickup. Cold weather and/or cold water (lower than 45°F/7°C) can result in slower particle dispersion. Due to particle sizing, this product is not recommended for use on greens.

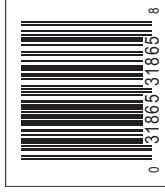
