If Swallowed: If spray solution containing pesticides is swallowed, follow the "Statement of Practical Treatment" on pesticide label. Do not induce vomiting or give fluids by mouth to an unconscious person. If person is conscious, immediately give large quantities of water and induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately. Always follow the precautionary statements on the label of the pesticide(s) being used. See MSDS for additional information on safe handling and use of this product.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is having difficulty breathing, give oxygen and get emergency medical help immediately.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

DELUX is a biodegradable activator surfactant and ammonium sulfate premix formulated to enhance the performance of generic Glyphosate and certain post emergence herbicides on weed species that are responsive to the presence of ammonium ions in the spray solution.

FOR USE WITH PESTICIDES REGISTERED FOR AQUATIC, GOLF COURSES, SOD FARMS, RECREATIONAL, COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL TURFGRASS AREAS, AS WELL AS SPORTS GRASS PLAYING AREAS, NONCROPLAND AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides and/or fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and/or fruit of desirable crops. Before using DELUX, the applicator or crops advisor must have experience with the pesticide combination, including DELUX, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity test. SHAKE WELL OR RECIRCULATE BEFORE USING IF PRODUCT HAS BEEN STORED BELOW 32°F

USE RATES:

Use 4 - 5 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution for phenoxy's.

Use 5 - 10 quarts per 100 gallons of spray solution for Manage®, Image® and Glyphosate applications in 10 - 50 gallons of spray solution per acre.

Use higher rates in higher water volumes.

MIXING:

Always mix this product in accordance with the instructions concerning additives found on the pesticide label. In the absence of specific mixing instructions, fill the spray tank 1/2 to 2/3 full of desired water volume. While the water is agitating, add pesticides and/or adjuvants in the following order:

- 1) Antifoam/Defoamer
- 2) DELUX
- 3) Dry flowables and dispersible granule pesticides
- 4) Flowable pesticides
- 5) Water-soluble pesticides
- 6) Emulsifiable concentrate pesticides
- 7) Add generic Glyphosate formulations last and continue filling tank to desired volume. Maintain agitation while spraying to ensure a uniform spray mixture.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

May be stored below 32°F if thawed and thoroughly agitated before use. Keep container closed in storage. Do not allow water to be introduced. Store only in original container. Triple rinse when empty and offer for recycling. Always dispose of container in accordance with local, state and/or federal regulations. Do not reuse empty container.
