This proprietary formulation of fenoxaprop, fluroxypyr and dicamba provides strong control of crabgrass, particularly in the mid-tiller stage of growth that quinclorac-based herbicides struggle with. Last Call also controls a number of broadleaf weeds including dandelion, clover and lespedeza, and it can also be used for the removal of bermudagrass from cool-season turf. Last Call can be applied to all managed turf areas including golf fairways and roughs, residential and commercial lawns, sod farms, sport fields and similar areas.

APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Last Call[™] is a systemic herbicide which controls emerged grasses and broadleaf weeds at time of spraying. Young, actively growing grass weeds are more easily controlled than larger grass weeds. Use 44 to 88 gallons of finished spray solution per acre for thorough coverage. For application rates, refer to the Application Rate chart below. Avoid applications to turfgrass under stress due to lack of moisture, chemical injury or temperature extremes. For adequate control, treat annual grass weeds between the 1 leaf to 4 tiller stage of growth.

BROADCAST TURF APPLICATION RATES

Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue, zoysiagrass	3.5 to 4.0	1.3 to 1.5

Bermudagrass sprav program:

To control bermudagrass, up to 4 applications spaced one month apart may be required. Make the first application in the fall. If necessary, repeat application in the spring when the bermudagrass begins to green up.

Do not make more than 4 applications per year at the 3.5 pts/A application rate.

Do not make more than 3 applications per year at the 4 pts/A application rate.

Do not apply more than 240 fl oz (15 pts)/A or 5.5 fl oz/1,000 sq ft per year.

A fall application to green bermudagrass prior to dormancy will prevent or delay reinfestation the following spring.

PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Avoid drift of spray mist to vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants. Do not pour spray solutions near desirable plants.

For use on Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue and zoysiagrass turf.

Do not apply to the following, as severe injury will result:

- Bermudagrass, bentgrass, St. Augustine (including floratam), centipedegrass or bahiagrass
- · Gardens including vegetables, fruit trees, vines and berries

Ornamental plants (flowers, trees, groundcovers, landscape beds and shrubs)

Do not apply more than 64 fl oz (4 pts)/A or 1.5 fl oz/1,000 sq ft of this product to Kentucky bluegrass, zoysiagrass, tall fescue, fine fescue or perennial ryegrass per application.

Do not apply more than 240 fl oz (15 pts)/A or 5.5 fl oz/1,000 sq ft per year.

Do not use this product on golf course putting greens or tees.
